2.2 To act as a Special Rapporteur in respect of work relating to prevention of Iron and Iodine Deficiency among the Expectant Mothers covering the above Southern States.

2.3 Such other assignments which the Commission may entrust from time to time.

3. A set of guidelines for Special Rapporteurs as enunciated by the Commission is enclosed for your reference. I am pleased to inform you that apart from the facilities stipulated therein, the Commission has decided that an honorarium of Rs. 12,500/- per month should be offered to you for your work.
